- We suggest hand weeding in autumn at the start of your project
- Use of the herbicide Glyphosate may be required

10 of our favourites are:


Conostylis candicans (grey cottonheads)

Eremophila glabra (tar bush) Grevillea crithmifolia Hemiandra pungens (snakebush) Carpobrotus virescens (pigface) Acacia lasiocarpa (dune moses) Leucophyta brownii (cushion bush)

Westringia dampieri Olearia axillaris (coastal daisybush)

Ficinia nodosa (knotted club-rush)

- We recommend planting in early winter
- Use small seedlings
- Use w etting agent







- Apply a thickfree-draining mulch in spring
- Weekly w atering grading to monthly over the first summer
- Continue w eed control
